Location: Midtown (also known as Borland Center) development on PGA Boulevard, Palm Beach Gardens

Why it's worth a visit: Sure, we've got plenty of high-end steakhouses in our area, but III Forks promises to be something different. It's known for its sides, including an off-the-cob creamed corn — served free with entrees. Piano-bar entertainment is also part of the mix. III Forks proprietor Consolidated Restaurant Operations also will bring Cantina Laredo, a gourmet Mexican establishment, to Midtown in early 2007.
